

VACANCY: ANAESTHETIC NURSING SISTER

Purpose: To demonstrate high clinical expertise in patient care and ensure a safe environment is established for optimal patient wellbeing during active participation in complex radiology procedures including but not limited to general anesthetics.

Task and Responsibilities:

- To assist with GA procedures for paediatric MRI and adhoc GA's for interventional examinations
- To support the anaesthetists in the department and help recover patients post GA
- Daily management of nursing activities within the radiology department including the assessment of patients waiting to undergo radiological examinations, during and post procedural care.
- To assist radiographers in all modalities and perform required nursing procedures.
- To support the Radiologist in the department and help recover patients in emergency situations.
- To demonstrate high clinical expertise in patient care and ensure a safe environment is established for optimal patient wellbeing.
- To have active participation in all procedures and interact with the patients, radiographers and radiologists to provide quality service and care.
- To assist with the administration of intravenous contrast and drugs.
- Manage and maintain all emergency equipment to comply with health and safety standards.
- Departmental stock control management.
- Communicate effectively any infectious patient risks to the relevant persons.
- Maintain mandatory BLS certification.
- Maintain and update infection control policies and correct disposal of waste.
- Ensure the emergency trolley is adequately stocked and up to date.
- Accurate reporting and follow up of incidents and extravasations.
- Process management of staff needlestick injuries and IODs.
- Responsible for facilitating staff medicals including hepatitis vaccination process
- Willing to stay late to assist with procedures and emergency situations.

- Understanding of the safety guidelines for MRI.
- Assist radiographers in all modalities with patient care.
- IV cannulation and injection of contrast media and sedation.
