

VACANCY: NURSING SISTER

Purpose: To demonstrate high clinical expertise in patient care and ensure a safe environment is established for optimal patient wellbeing during active participation in complex radiology procedures including but not limited to Interventional Radiology, CT, Ultrasound, MRI scanning procedures.

Task and Responsibilities:

- Daily management and coordination of nursing activities within the radiology and interventional radiology department.
- Assess, prepare, monitor, and recover patients undergoing diagnostic and interventional radiology procedures.
- Assist radiologists during interventional procedures including sterile scrubbing, circulating, and maintaining aseptic technique.
- Prepare procedure rooms, sterile trays, consumables, and specialized interventional equipment.
- Assist with vascular access procedures, biopsies, drain insertions, ablations, angiography, and other image-guided interventions.
- Monitor patients during conscious sedation and respond appropriately to emergencies or adverse reactions.
- Support radiographers across all modalities and assist with required nursing procedures.
- Administer intravenous contrast media, medications, and emergency drugs in accordance with protocols and scope of practice.
- Demonstrate high clinical expertise in patient care and ensure a safe environment for optimal patient wellbeing.
- Ensure effective communication between patients, radiologists, radiographers, referring clinicians, and nursing staff.
- Manage and maintain emergency equipment and ensure compliance with health and safety standards.
- Ensure the emergency trolley is fully stocked, checked, and up to date at all times.
- Maintain accurate patient documentation, incident reporting, and follow-up of contrast reactions, extravasations, and clinical incidents.
- Facilitate and manage staff needlestick injury processes and IOD documentation.
- Coordinate staff medicals and hepatitis vaccination processes.
- Manage departmental stock control, consumables, and ordering processes.
- Maintain infection prevention and control standards, including waste disposal and sterile field management.
- Communicate infectious risks promptly to the relevant healthcare personnel.
- Participate in departmental quality improvement initiatives and compliance audits.
- Maintain mandatory BLS certification; ACLS certification will be advantageous.
- Participate in after-hours, emergency, and extended procedural support when required.

Core Competencies:

- Understanding of nursing practices required in Radiology.
- Understanding of the radiation rules and guidelines.
- Understanding of the safety guidelines for MRI.
- IV cannulation and injection of contrast media and sedation.
- Stock control.
- Knowledge of conscious sedation, sterile technique, and radiology procedures.
- Strong clinical, organisational, and communication
